KIERAN Strachan's two consecutive best and fairest seasons with South Bendigo have caught the attention of Essendon's VFL team.



After training with the Dons' VFL squad for the previous three weeks, ruckman Strachan has earned a place on the list for 2017.

"I have a mutual connection with the coach (Paul Corrigan) and my name was thrown up with what I've done at South and they invited me down to have a go," Strachan said on Saturday. "I don't think they knew too much about me, but it has gone from there and I've been lucky enough that I guess they like what they have seen at training. "I'm still fairly skinny, so I think it will be more of a development year... I'm not sure what opportunities I'll get next year, but it's good to be in that pathway now."

Essendon VFL operations manager Ashley Brown told the club's website the 20-year-old had impressed in training with his endurance and agility. "Kieran is able to get involved in play regularly around the ground due to his mobility," Brown said. "He even beat quite a number of our midfielders in our recent two kilometre time trial."

Strachan will be aligned with South Bendigo – where he has been appointed co-captain with Aaron Connaughton – meaning when he's not selected for Essendon he will still play for the Bloods in the Bendigo Football-Netball League.

"He's a 203cm big man, mobile and with good skills and it's a great opportunity for him," South Bendigo coach Brady Childs said. "He has developed really well over the past couple of years and we're really supportive of Kieran to take on this opportunity and we're looking forward to seeing how he goes."

Essendon bowed out of the VFL in the second week of the finals this year when defeated by eventual premier Footscray by 19 points.

Strachan was named the ruckman in the *Bendigo Advertiser* BFNL Team of the Year in 2016.

FROM THE COACHES – BRADY CHILDS

Senior footballers commenced preseason training with much enthusiasm back in early November last year and, following a short break over the festive season, recommenced full training in early January. Numbers at training have been steadily increasing to a point where around 40 players are on the track on a weekly basis. Late February to early March will see the Uni boys back on the track, so numbers will continue to grow.

Dan Farrelly has the lads on a solid and effective training program and GPS data comparison shows the boys are fitter and stronger then the same time last year. It is amazing how effective wearing a GPS vest at training can bring the best out of individuals and the competition between the lads is very healthy, a recent session put the boys up to 11km!!!

Brady and the coaching panel have been very active in the "off season" and the club has strategically recruited some very high quality people and players to the club. These include Kaiden Antonowitz (Shepparton Swans), Reegan and Brock Harvey (Golden Square), Zac Hare (Koondrook Barham), Joel Swatton (Return from a year off), James Oliver (St Alban - son of Steven, our own SOS), Tom Brereton (White Hills), Nathan Devanny (Marong), Andy Van Hueman, Marty Nadort, Mitch Gardner (returns from White Hills) Ben Dreshler (soccer background), Daniel (Redda) Johnstone (Mooroopna). There is also a number of guys training who we hope will commit over the next week or so. In addition, the club is really excited to have 3 lads aligning with South from the Pioneers TAC squad. They are Riley Burns (Mildura Imperials) and Lewin Davis (Mildura Demons).

This weekend the boys head to Ocean Grove to the preseason camp, in which over 40 players will attend, over the two days they will participate in various fitness/skill session, hear from specialist coaches, and continue to develop game plans and the Bloods Culture!!!

The feeling and enthusiasm around the playing group is very strong and positive and all the lads and coaching panel are all looking forward to putting all the hard work onto the park in the upcoming practice matches for a fair dinkum hit-out. We can't wait for you to see the talent and potential of this terrific group of footballers that will represent South in 2017.

Practice matches are scheduled against Balwyn Tigers for the Shaun Bergen Memorial game on March 18th at Epsom, Bell Park on March 25th at Harry Trott and Colbinabbin on April 1st (location TBC). South Bendigo coach Brady Childs is expecting the Bloods' improvement to come from within in 2017.

The young South Bendigo squad only won one more game in 2016 compared to 2015, but it was the way they played that showed why Bloods fans have plenty to look forward to in the years to come.

"We're expecting 10 to 20 per cent improvement from the younger players that had a year of senior footy under their belt last year," Childs said.

"We'll continue to develop those younger players... that's why we haven't gone and out and recruited heavily.

"We've only lost three senior players (Rory Alexander, Charles Trottman and Matt Chisari), so we think we're well placed to improve again this year."

Childs, who missed 2016 because of a knee reconstruction, has trained strongly in the preseason and will be a key addition to the Bloods' midfield.

South Bendigo's first pre-season game is against Balwyn in Bendigo on March 18. The Bloods then play Bell Park in Bendigo on March 25 before rounding out their pre-season campaign against Colbinabbin at a venue yet to be decided on April 1.

South Bendigo opens the 2017 BFNL season against Eaglehawk at the QEO on Good Friday.




