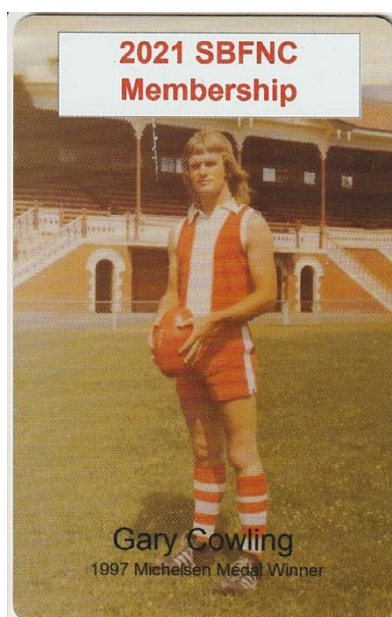

If you were a member of any of these teams, please get in contact with your premiership team mates to let them know about the intended event.

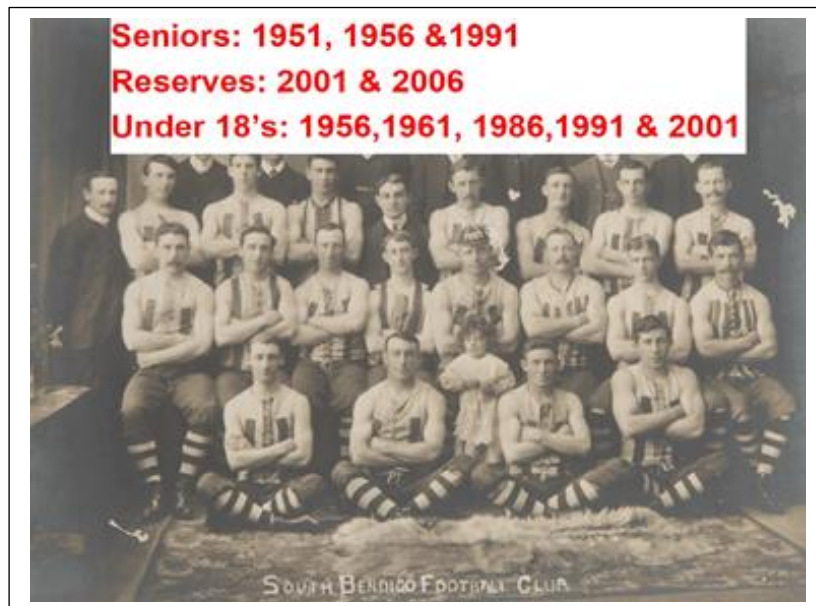
It would be fantastic if each of those teams had a “champion” who took it upon themselves to locate and update the contact details for all of their old teammates and pass this on to the club.

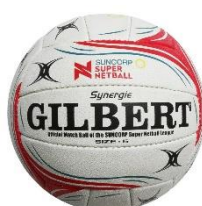

### BSNA NEWS



As most of you would know the Bendigo Strathdale Netball Association (BSNA) competition will not be held at the Bendigo South East College this year. This year the competition will be held on outside courts across three venues, the Bendigo Stadium - Inglis Street, West Bendigo, the Strathdale netball courts – Cnr Mclvor Hwy & Reservoir

Road, Strathdale and our own South Bendigo courts – Harry Trott Oval, Neale Street Kennington.

**Sections 1, 2, 3C and 4 will be playing Friday night games at the Bendigo Stadium** whilst **Sections 3A, 3B, Grade 6, Grade 5, Grade 4 and Grade 3 will be played Saturdays at the South Bendigo courts** and **13/Under A and B will be held at the Strathdale courts**. Game times should be the same as in 2019 except the Friday night games will start 15 minutes earlier, that is, Section 4 will begin at 5:00pm instead of 5:15pm.



## GET ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER PROGRAM

The State Gov't are providing support to eligible families to get kids involved in organised sport and recreation activities by reimbursing the cost of membership and registration fees, uniforms and equipment. Eligible children may be able to receive up to \$200 each [Get Active vouchers](#)

*To be eligible for a voucher your child/dependant must be:*

- *aged 4 to 18 years*
- *a resident in Victoria*
- *named on a current (at the time of your application) Australian Government Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, and*
- *named on a valid Australian Government Medicare card.*

*You can apply for more than one voucher if you have multiple eligible children/dependants.*

You must apply separately for each child/dependant.

If you don't have an Australian Government Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card you may still be eligible for [special consideration](#).

To apply you will need to submit a copy of your fees receipt. If you need a copy of your receipt log onto [my netball](#). Click on the **activity tab** and then **the purchases tab**.

Identify the invoice you want the receipt for and choose from the options to print the receipt.

Our Coach Nathan Horbury continued to stress the importance of our game plan regardless of the individuals playing and it was a good opportunity for a number of players to get some senior footy experience.

In the final preseason practice match, still missing a number of our senior players, we had a good test against a strong Goulburn Valley League side in Rochester. Highlights of this match were patches of exceptional football with great ball movement played against a first-rate side.

We now have the Easter weekend off before our seasons first game against Castlemaine at Castlemaine in which we are looking to get our season off to a good start.

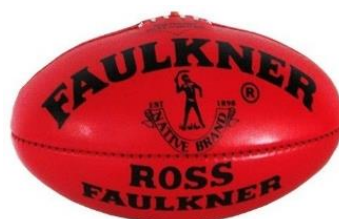
We are pleased to announce that Senior Co-Captain Zac Hare has taken on the Under 18's coaching role for this season.

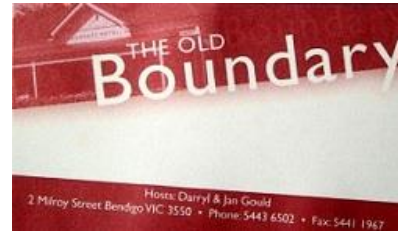
