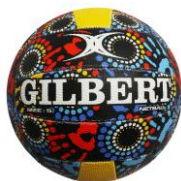

Round 11 Saturday 29th June v Eaglehawk

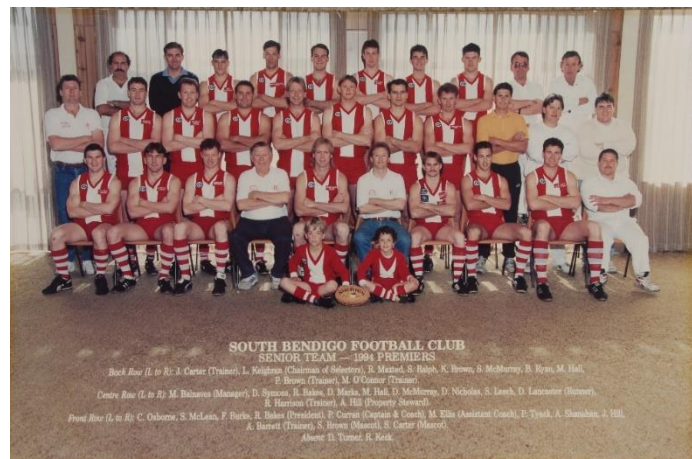
