

#### **VALE TWO CHAMPIONS OF OUR CLUB**

2020 started on a sad note with the passing of two absolute champions of our club in Frank Lenaghan and Lloyd Jones. Both men, along with Norm Cowling, were the only players to play in all 5 of Alan McDonalds champion Premiership sides between 1950 and 1956, a golden age in the history of South Bendigo.


In addition to team success both men accomplished considerable personal achievement wearing the Red and White for the Bloods; Frank winning the Club's Senior Best & Fairest in 1952 and 1957 with Lloyd being Club Champion in 1954.

Both were Vice Captains to Alan McDonald in the 1956 premiership winning side. The following are extracts from "South Bendigo Personalities" in the 1956 Grand Final Record: **FRANK LENAGHAN:** Rover. One of the smallest players in the League, but what he lacks in size he makes up for in football ability. A brilliant rover now in top form, Frank, a most determined player is particularly clever in scouting the packs. 153 games; 135 goals. **LLOYD JONES:** Utility player. Has given the club grand service over the past few years. A most tireless and determined player Lloyd can be played in almost any position and be equally effective. 141 games; 132 goals.



Frank Lenaghan was made a Life Member of our Club in 1957 and Lloyd Jones awarded the same honour the following year in 1958. Up until last year when ill health prevented Frank from attending both men were regulars at our annual Life Members Luncheon where it was obvious how highly both men were still regarded by their peers. Both modest champions and true gentlemen their attendance and presence back at the club on those occasions will be sadly missed.



#### **CANTEEN SERVICES POSITION DESCRIPTION**

#### **Objectives**

- To assist the Canteen Co-ordinator in providing an appropriate catering service for match days.
- To ensure the efficient operation of the Club canteen activities

#### Responsibilities

- Hold a current Food Handling Certificate.
   Note: The Club will support & subsidise obtaining this qualification for any volunteer not currently holding this certificate
- Ensure canteen is open for business at the commencement of the first match of each home game.
- Comply with the requirements of the food safety plan.
- Assist the Canteen team with the canteen closure routines such as storing of stock & cleaning tasks
- Support the Canteen Co-ordinator to ensure adequate stock is in supply for match days.
- Assist the Canteen Co-ordinator in the purchase and pick up of stock from suppliers
- Liaise with Team Managers to arrange a voluntary labour roster to ensure the canteen is appropriately staffed on match days
- Maintain strong relationships with all Club suppliers throughout the football season.

#### Time Required

Approximately 7 hours for each of 9 home games each season.

#### WHEN YOU'RE ON YOUR PHONE, YOU'RE DRIVING BLIND



Keeping your eyes on the road is essential for safe driving. But when you look at your phone, you're oblivious to what's around you. In fact, at 50km per hour, even a 2 second glance at your phone means you'll travel up to 28 metres blind. What will you miss?

#### What you can do to avoid distracted driving?

- Install the 'do not disturb' function on your phone. This is a default feature on many phones that you can find in the settings. If your phone doesn't have this feature there are apps you can download to use it.
- Put your phone out of reach such as in the glovebox or car boot.
- Turn your phone on silent, or turn it off completely when driving.
- As a passenger, speak up and encourage others to be safe.
